

Tumbler

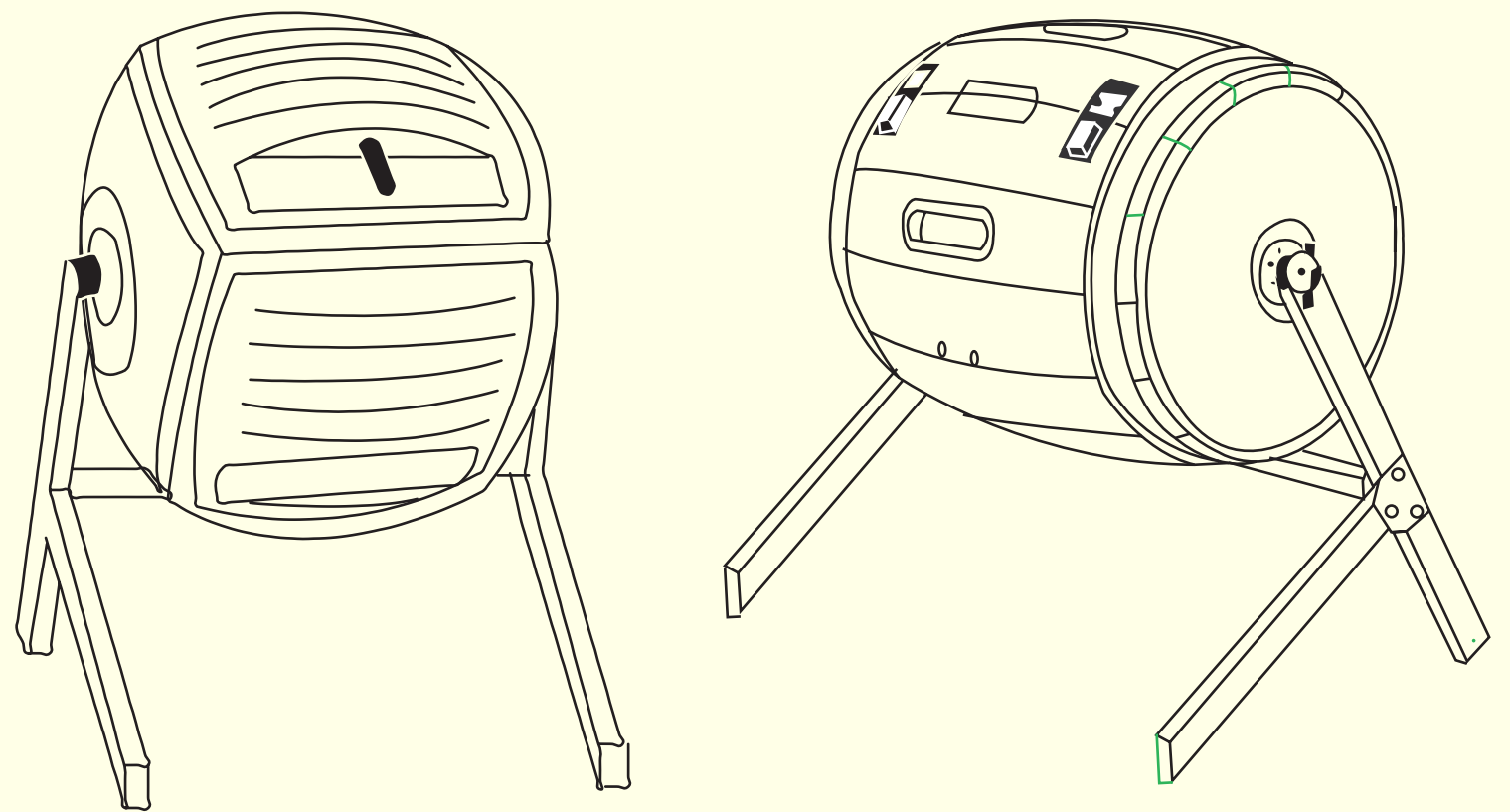
Tumble into composting!

Tumbler systems can be found at many garden centers. They can be as simple as a large, closable container that is rolled around on the ground. Some are easier to use than others. All of them work efficiently with the proper combination of

- Browns & greens (carbon & nitrogen)
- Temperature & moisture
- Aeration — turning the container mixes contents and introduces oxygen

Feed the Tumbler a mix of food scraps and yard waste, give them a drink of water when they need it, and give the whole barrel a tumble or three as you fill it. When you empty your tumbler, it's best to let the material rest for a month before planting. Try giving ours a spin!

Tumblers come in different shapes and sizes!



Composting is alchemy

Organic materials — food scraps, yard clippings, woody material, clean papers and more — can be used to regenerate healthy soils and protect water quality through composting to create rich humus.
